



Student Admission Information

Khalsa School Calgary offers an academically rigorous program. As a result, we require all new students to undergo academic entrance testing to ensure that Khalsa School Calgary is a good fit for the student *and* that the student is a good fit for Khalsa School Calgary.

Registration Process

Parents interested in enrolling their child at Khalsa School must fill out a Pre-Registration form.

Students are accepted for admission in the following order:

1. *Returning students.* Students must indicate if they will be returning for the following school year by re-registering and paying the initial fee payment by the re-registration deadline.
2. *Siblings.* A child who has a brother or sister attending Khalsa School Calgary and children of staff members are granted sibling status. Students with sibling status will be invited for admissions testing during the first week of March.
3. *General Public.* Any remaining openings will be filled by new registrations based on the date on the Pre-Registration Form. Applications will be accepted from the general public and these students will be invited for admissions testing during the second and third weeks of March.

Kindergarten Registration Process

Parents interested in enrolling their child in Kindergarten must fill out a Pre-Registration Form. Children with sibling status will be given priority. Remaining openings will be filled based on the date on the Pre-Registration form. Kindergarten admission testing will take place during the last week of January.

Admission Testing & Grade Placement

All new students who apply at Khalsa School Calgary (Kindergarten – 9) will undergo admissions testing. This testing, together with the input of the administration, will determine the appropriate grade level placement for each student.

Fees & Tuition

A \$20.00 non-refundable testing fee must be paid at the time of admission testing. This testing fee covers the cost of the testing materials as well as the cost of school personnel to administer the test.

Required tuition and fees will be paid at the time of registration, as per the current fee schedule.

English Language Learners (English Second Language)

Khalsa School Calgary has a dedicated team of professionals, many of whom are bilingual in Punjabi and English. We provide both in-class support and student services support to students who are identified as being English Language Learners.
